The Data Controller

Mayo, Sligo and Leitrim Education and Training Board (MSLETB) is the Data Controller for all personal data which is collected and used by www.youthreachsligo.ie website. A Data Controller is the legal entity which determines how and why personal data is collected and used.

What Personal Data We Collect

Personal data is any information relating to you which allows Youthreach Sligo to identify you, such as your name & address, contact phone numbers and email address. Most areas of www.youthreachsligo.ie website can be accessed by you without the need for you to provide any of your personal data. Some areas may require you to voluntarily submit your name, email address, and other contact details. Youthreach Sligo website collects and uses personal data about you, such as:

- Your IP address
- Information about your use of this website

We will process any data you share with in line with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and Data Protection Law.

What we use your Personal Data for

Any personal data we collect from you on this website will be used by Youthreach Sligo for purposes such as:

- To provide you with a better customer experience by making services available online.
- Analysis of visitor traffic to and usage of our website.

We will not use any personal information in any manner other than the purpose for which it was provided. Youthreach Sligo may use anonymised data from this website for the purposes of analysing, planning and improving the service. This anonymised data will not include any of your personal data.

How long will we hold onto your Personal Data

We will only retain your personal data for as long as it is necessary to fulfil the purpose it is being processed for. All personal data collected by Youthreach Sligo is retained in accordance with MSLETB's Record Retention Policy and all records are securely deleted in line with our policy. Who will have access to your Personal Data

Youthreach Sligo staff who are directly involved with the management of www.youthreachsligo.ie website will have access to your personal data which is collected by this website.

All Youthreach Sligo staff, agents and suppliers who have access to personal data are obliged to keep your personal data secure, and to use it only for the purposes specified by Youthreach Sligo. For further information on how personal data is accessed please see our [Cookie Policy](#).

Will my personal data be transferred outside of the European Economic Area (EEA)

Youthreach Sligo does not transfer any other personal data about you outside the EEA. If Youthreach Sligo decides to transfer your personal data outside the EEA they shall ensure the provisions of Chapter V of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) are complied with.

Youthreach Sligo uses Google Analytics to collect information about your use of this website and part of this information includes your IP address which is considered personal data.

What are your Rights

Under legislation, and in certain circumstances, you have the following rights:

- Right of access – you have the right to request a copy of the information that we hold about you.
- Right of rectification – you have a right to correct data that we hold about you that is inaccurate or incomplete.
- Right to be forgotten – in certain circumstances you can ask for the data we hold about you to be erased from our records.
- Right to restriction of processing – where certain conditions apply to have a right to restrict the processing.

- Right of portability – where certain conditions apply, you have the right to have the data we hold about you transferred to another organisation.
- Right to object – you have the right to object to certain types of processing such as direct marketing.
- Right to object to automated processing, including profiling – you also have the right to be subject to the legal effects of automated processing or profiling.
- Right to review: in the event that the HSE's refuses your request under rights of access, we will provide you with a reason as to why.
- Withdraw your consent – where you have consented to receiving emails or newsletters you may withdraw your consent at any time

Making a complaint
